# Enrollment Application Process for New Families

Our enrollment process allows for parents to get to know our school as well as familiarize themselves with our philosophy and curriculum.

The process involves the following steps:

- 1. **Learn More:** Review our website (www.cedargroveschool.ca) for information about our school, educational philosophy and curriculum.
- 2. **Book a Call (optional):** Email <u>admin@cedargroveschool.ca</u> to schedule an exploratory phone call with the Administrative Director.
  - \*Please note: as we are completing the construction of our school building, it will not be available to tour until late summer 2025
- 3. Complete Application Form: available at www.cedargroveschool.ca
- 4. Participate in an Admissions Meeting: The Admissions Meeting is an opportunity for the parents and student to meet Faculty members and allows the Faculty members to observe the student's readiness for the program. Based on the meeting, observations, and information shared, the Faculty will determine whether the needs of the student can be met within our programs.
  - \*Please note: due to ongoing construction, Admissions Meetings will be held over Google Meet.
- 5. **Offer of Enrolment:** We aim to notify parents of admissions confirmation within two weeks of the Admissions Meeting. If confirmed, we invite parents to complete the enrolment process as soon as possible to secure the student's spot.
- 6. **Complete Enrolment Agreement Form:** To be emailed to families along with Offer of Enrolment
- 7. **Submit Registration Fee and Deposit:** Registration Fee and Deposit are collected to complete enrolment and secure the student's spot. Both are non-refundable, however the deposit is deducted from the first tuition payment (due September 1st). Payable by e-transfer to admin@cedargroveschool.ca.

All required forms and commitment to pay must be on file before children may attend school. All existing families must have accounts in good standing in order to re-enrol.

## Probationary Period Policy

For new students, the first 6 weeks of attendance are a **probationary period**. This can be extended, in writing, at the discretion of the Faculty. During the probationary period the family will have the opportunity to become familiar with the school, and the Faculty will be able to observe the student's needs and abilities. If a student's needs cannot be met by our program and our staff, we will meet with the parents to share observations and discuss options. The school reserves the right to discharge a student if we are unable to meet the student's needs.

## Withdrawal and Refund Policy

If a family withdraws after September 1, 2025, and before May 1, 2026, one full month's written notice and payment is required.

Amounts owing (if any) will be calculated based on our September 1st through June 1st standard schedule. If a family withdraws from extended care programming, one full month's written notice and payment is required.

After May 1, 2026, no refund will be given. If Cedar Grove School is unable to meet the student's needs, the school reserves the right to discharge a student. All prior payments are considered non-refundable. If a family is not on a standard payment plan, any amounts owing will be calculated on a September through June schedule.
